Focus Area as per the CSR Policy: Education & Livelihood

KIAL’s Livelihood programmes and/or projects will work towards imparting vocational skills and development training courses to children, youth, women, war widows, war veterans, elderly, and the differently-abled including school and college dropouts or anyone who never had any formal education (illiterate) through technical, soft and trade and commerce skills which will help them earn a livelihood and/or enhance their livelihood in rural, semi urban. KIAL may also undertake any other programmes and/or projects which would focus on the education sector and/or livelihood sector, as may be approved by the CSR Committee.

Kotak Shiksha Nidhi is a collaborative CSR Project on Education & Livelihood of Kotak Mahindra Group companies, which is being implemented by Kotak Education Foundation (KEF).
